I hear that the Argentines were at first quite riled by some harsh words in the Israeli statement to them in re the Eichmann case. The Argentines resented the reminder that they had been harboring so many Nazis. This noon, I will have lunch with the Histadrut representative here. I have a proposal to make to the Israelis:

My proposal is that Eichmann be put in the custody of the Argentine Embassy in Tel Aviv. That he be kept there. Secondly, that such transfer be considered recognition by the Israeli of Argentine sovereignty in this matter and that in the interim proceedings be taken for extradition of Eichmann from this Argentine territory to Israeli authority. I think this is valid since the territory of the Argentine legation or embassy in Tel Aviv is Argentine.

Now, of course, the question arises here where shall he be tried? If the U. N. is to act on it, it can make only one decision according to the Convention on Genocide -- the criminal must be tried in the land where he committed the crime. Everybody in the U. N. Security Council feels uncomfortable about it.

This morning the press reports that the Polish and Soviet representation of the Security Council are agreed to back Israel. My information is different. I learned from Argentine sources that the Soviet representation has been trying to get in touch with the Argentines with a view of giving support to the Argentine position. However, I don't vouch at this point for what the Russians will do.

You see there is one angle in the whole picture which has been neglected by the U. N. observers. That angle is the following: The Israelis are not interested in revenge or in executing Eichmann. The Israelis want to stage a big show trial. Now in every show trial there must be a villain and a culprit. It is not in Israeli interests to make the Germans the villains or culprits at this time. What the Israelis want to do is to get out of Eichmann facts and names in re the role of some of the worst Nazis after 1945 in Arab countries, particularly in Egypt and Syria.

Given this fact, which I am sure sooner or later Moscow will come to think of, I can't see the Kremlin supporting the Israeli in the Security Council. Again, I may be wrong.

Eichmann Held By New Order

Jew Is Seeking

To Ask Eichmann

LONDON, June 19 (AP) — A Jew who calls his relatives in Nazi concentration camps wants to defend Adolf Eichmann because he disapproves of the way the Gestapo man was arrested here, *Empire News* said today. The newspaper identified him as Paul Szekely.

MADEIRA, June 19 — Major Gen. Jose Bach today ordered Eichmann into custody for a further 14 days. Adolf Eichmann, former U.S. Colonel now awaiting trial for war crimes and the mass murder of 6 million Jews under the Nazi regime. The last such order, issued June 3, expires Monday. Eichmann was brought to

Israel last month from Argentina by Israeli agents. Under Israeli legal procedure, the police may seek a remand extension for only one more 15-day period. This means that by July 22, formal charges will have to be laid. After that, the magistrate could order Eichmann's arrest pending trial.

Reality vs. Niceties at the U. N.

U-2 and Eichmann Cases Are Called Heartening Intelligence Indicators

For the second time within weeks the United Nations faces a contest between the inescapable realities of present life and the outmoded diplomatic niceties of the 19th Century. Again it is a case where conditions, facts clash with a theory that was no doubt all right in a world of safety now long gone.

A little while ago the Security Council was solemnly trying to find a way out of the United States for the spy plane, not sending a spy plane over the Soviet Union. The Soviet Union's charge—violation of its neutrality—was gravel, not though to other nations, and surely not the scrupulously nice apparatus of international communism had ever operated espionage. And this in a world where espionage is as real and universal as the desire of nations to repel all else.

Now Israel shortly goes before the U.N. to answer Argentina's complaint that her sovereignty, too, has been violated by the capture in Argentina by Israeli volunteers of the infamous Nazi Adolf Eichmann.

Here was a man charged with the systematic murder of 6 million Jews in the Hitler era. For 14 years the tireless Israelis had been on his track until at last they found him and took him off to Israel to be tried for crimes too horrible to be much discussed.

The Argentines had put no slightest finger of accusation or of punishment upon him though he had come there illegally and illegally had remained. For the Security Council now to attempt to order his return to Argentina would be unthinkable for two reasons. First, it would mean the Eichmann would continue to cheat the justice already long overdue. The U. N. has no courtroom and prison, no power to punish nor has any

other existing international instrumentality.

Second, the Israelis in any case would politely but firmly tell the U. N. that they were very sorry but that Eichmann would face an Israeli court of justice all the same.

No conceivable Israeli government could ever allow this man out of its hands. Just as conceivable United Nations might could ever balk at its responsibility to protect this nation from surprise attack upon all governments there are duties which go beyond pleasing an international organization, the U. N., which is wholly unable to protect anybody from the fact that crime still goes on in this world.

So the true importance of this case is not related to the fine spin of legalism of the U. N. The true importance of the U. N. case did not lie in such legalisms. The real point for the last U. N. trial was that it highlighted the enormous success of American counter-espionage in having penetrated for four years the skies over the flowering Iron Curtain.

The real point of the coming U. N. trial from Israel is its dramatization of a hitherto little-known (or the spectacular efficiency of Israel's security and counter-espionage. The respondent in a visit to Argentina ago saw a little of the system as well as troubled fronts. What was seen then—and never will be—was the human form of the topmost

man in Israel's intelligence operations. This man is wisely kept nameless by the Israeli government, as the British government keeps absolutely secret the identity of its very top security man. (The United States, in the person of Allen Dulles of the Central Intelligence Agency, makes its top man known.)

The man in Israel's cloak-and-dagger establishment is truly cloaked though carrying no dagger. The public will never know who he is, the Israelis will not disclose his identity even in the coming Eichmann trial.

Many of our wisest friends abroad were far from offended by the U-2 episode. On the contrary, they were immensely heartened to learn how successful American intelligence could be. All our Westerners can be heartened that the Israelis, as staunch Western allies, have shown that they, too, know how to do it in Tel Aviv and Jerusalem and everywhere.

Fronzi Indicates He Would Return Eichmann to Israel

MILAN (Italy, June 20 (AP).—Argentina's President Arturo Frondizi says his government plans to send Adolf Eichmann back to Israel if the Israelis return the ex-Gestapo official to Argentina.

Mr. Frondizi on a state visit to Italy told a group of Argentine newsmen yesterday that extradition would be granted if conditions of international law were met. He denied he had ever said Eichmann would be extradited to West Germany if handed over by Israel.

Jewish agents seized Eichmann in Buenos Aires last month and whisked him to Israel to be tried for a major responsibility in the deaths of millions of Jews during World War II. The United Nations Security Council met Wednesday to take up Argentina's complaint that Eichmann's capture violated Argentine sovereignty.
